Appropriation for 1916.-- County home, poorhouse and outside poor and aid to Confederate veterans, \$4,000. Improvements Noted.--Shingle roofs of some houses for paupers repaired, some painting and whitewashing. Superintendent s house repaired, rooms ceiled and some painting done. Recommendations.--Drive a pump at least 30 feet deep at the paupers quarters. Replace surface closets with fly-proof privies of the wet type. Cook the food for white inmates in the almshouse kitchen and let them eat their meals in the room adjoining the negro s dining room. Pickens Almshouse. Visited November 30, 1916. Located about 2 miles...
